Campo Escuela Scout (Scout School Field - 36 acres 23km from  
Tegucigalpa near Valle de Angeles (Angels Valley)

Arrive 25 December - reservations needed soon!

Altitude 4265' - 55-78 temps est.; may have some drizzle  
Scouts 11-16 years of age

Camporee Fee \$150/person includes transport at Camporee,  
meals (14 sessions) cold dinner 26<sup>th</sup> thru dinner 31<sup>st</sup>. dinners cooked by  
patrol; badge and neckerchief included

5 camping areas with bathrooms, electrician, kitchen and dining rooms,  
central ceremony area, and bonfire area, chapel and infirmary .

Will have optional food to purchase and a scout store

Paid laundry available; paid cell phone service also;

Bring 2 uniforms and 3 clothing changes, sports clothes, boots,  
jacket, raincoat, personal care, sleeping bag, lantern, camera,

Patrol bring camping tent, pioneering eqpt, compass, whistle, cooking  
eqpt, stove, patrol flag, national flag for delegations, first aid kit
